- AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to requiring the office of children and family services to maintain a database of available beds for runaway and/or homeless youth

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 2	Section 1. Subdivision 8 of section 532-e of the executive law is renumbered subdivision 9.
3	§ 2. Paragraph (e) of subdivision 7 of section 532-e of the executive
4	law, as added by chapter 361 of the laws of 2019, is amended and a new
5	subdivision 8 is added to read as follows:
6	(e) how to address the families of lesbian, gay, bisexual, and trans-
7	gender youth; [and]
8	8. work with service providers to gather information to create and
9	<u>maintain a publicly searchable database of available beds at residential</u>
10	facilities currently available for runaway and/or homeless youth on the
11	office's website and on a companion phone application. Such database
12	shall be updated in real time and shall provide and be searchable by the
13	following information:
14	(a) the name and address of the facility;
15	(b) the number of beds available at the facility;
16	(c) the age range allowable for the available bed;
17	(d) the length of time the runaway and/or homeless youth may stay at
18	the facility; and
19	(e) the services offered at the facility; and
20	§ 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
