AN ACT to amend the labor law, in relation to making unemployment insurance benefits available to essential federal workers during a federal government shutdown

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The labor law is amended by adding a new section 591-b to 2 read as follows:
- § 591-b. Federal shutdown; benefits for essential federal workers. 1.
 4 As used in this section, the term:
 - (a) "essential federal worker":

- 6 (i) means an employee of a federal government agency who is required 7 to work without pay during a shutdown; and
 - (ii) is a resident of this state; and
- 9 (b) "shutdown" means any period in which there is more than a twenty10 four hour lapse in appropriations for any federal government agency or
 11 federal department as a result of a failure of the federal government to
 12 enact a regular appropriations bill or continuing resolution.
- 2. Any essential federal worker shall be eligible for unemployment
- 14 <u>insurance benefits pursuant to this article during the period of a shut-</u>
 15 <u>down. If a shutdown ends and an essential federal worker is paid by the</u>
- 16 federal government for any period of time the essential federal worker
- 17 worked without pay during the shutdown, the essential federal worker
- 18 shall reimburse the unemployment insurance fund in an amount equal to
- 19 the unemployment insurance benefits the essential federal worker
- 20 received during the period of the shutdown. Such reimbursement of unem-
- 21 ployment insurance benefits by such essential federal worker shall occur
- 22 within ninety days after the end of such shutdown. The provisions of
- 23 this section shall apply regardless of passage of federal legislation or
- 24 the issuance of federal guidance from the United States department of
- 25 labor or another federal agency which allows an essential federal worker
- 26 to receive unemployment insurance benefits.
- 27 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
