AN ACT to amend the education law and the social services law, in relation to notifying individuals that certain work-study, internship, externship or other work placements offered by institutions of higher education meet the work requirements of title nine-B of article five of the social services law

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Part 4 of article 14 of the education law is amended by adding a new section 685 to read as follows:
 - § 685. Work-study, internship, externship or other work placements. Any CUNY, SUNY or other degree granting institution providing work-study, internship, externship or other work placements that are part of the curriculum shall notify applicants on the application forms that such work-study, internship, externship or other work placements that are part of the curriculum meet the work requirements of title nine-B of article five of the social services law for public assistance.
- 10 § 2. The social services law is amended by adding a new section 337-a 11 to read as follows:
- § 337-a. Notification to applicants. The department shall notify applicants on application forms that certain CUNY, SUNY or other degree granting institution providing work-study, internship, externship or other work placements that are part of the curriculum, meet the work requirements of this title.
- 17 § 3. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall 18 have become a law.
