AN ACT to authorize the assessor of the county of Nassau to accept an application for exemption from real property taxes from Iglesia Long Island Para Cristo Inc. for a certain parcel in the town of Hempstead

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, 2 the assessor of the county of Nassau is hereby authorized to accept from Iglesia Long Island Para Cristo Inc. an application for exemption from real property taxes pursuant to section 420-a of the real property tax law for a portion of the 2016-2017 school and the 2017 general tax roll for the parcel located in the town of Hempstead at 177 Harvard Ave., also known as 24 James LL Burrell Ave., Hempstead, otherwise known as: 8 section 34, block 248, lot 109 and 110. If accepted, such application shall be reviewed as if it had been received on or before the taxable 9 10 status dates established for such rolls. If satisfied that such non-pro-11 fit would otherwise be entitled to such exemption if such non-profit had 12 filed an application for exemption by the appropriate taxable status 13 dates, the assessor, upon approval of the Nassau county legislature, may grant exemption from all taxation and make appropriate corrections to the subject rolls. If such exemption is granted and such non-profit 15 16 therefore shall have paid any tax with respect to the subject rolls, the 17 governing body or tax department may, in its sole discretion, provide 18 for the refund of those taxes paid and cancel any taxes, fines, penal-19 ties, interest or tax liens remaining unpaid. 20 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
