AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to including hexavalent chromium in the list of emerging contaminants

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Paragraph c of subdivision 3 of section 1112 of the public health law, as added by section 1 of part M of chapter 57 of the laws of 2017, is amended to read as follows:
- c. The commissioner shall, at a minimum, include the following chemicals identified as emerging contaminants: 1,4-dioxane; hexavalent chromium (chromium-6); perfluorooctanesulfonic acid; and perfluorooctanoic acid.
- § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
