AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, relation to requiring new homeless shelters conduct a public hearing in the community where the proposed shelter is to be located before being sited

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The administrative code of the city of New York is amended by adding a new section 21-324 to read as follows:

§ 21-324 Community involvement. a. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the department shall establish a process for the siting of new homeless shelters for adults, other than short-term emergency homeless shelters.

b. The process developed by the department under this section shall include conducting at least one public hearing on the siting of any new 9 homeless shelter. Such public hearings shall be held in the community 10 district in which such proposed homeless shelter is to be located.

§ 2. This act shall take effect one year after it shall have become a law. Effective immediately, the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any 12 rule or regulation necessary for the implementation of this act on its 13 effective date are authorized to be made and completed on or before such 15 effective date.
