AN ACT to amend the village law and the public officers law, in relation authorizing the village of Riverside to hire a village clerk/treasurer and code enforcement officer who is not a resident of such village

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 3-300 of the village law is amended by adding a new subdivision 30 to read as follows:

30. Notwithstanding any provisions of this chapter or any other general law, local law, ordinance, or special act, the village board of trustees of the incorporated village of Riverside, Steuben county, may, by resolution, provide that the village clerk/treasurer and code enforcement officer of the village of Riverside, Steuben county, need not be a resident of such village, but must be a resident of the county in which 9 such village is located or an adjoining county within the state of New 10 **York.**

§ 2. Section 3 of the public officers law is amended by adding a new 11 subdivision 70 to read as follows: 12

70. In the village of Riverside, in the county of Steuben, the provisions of this section requiring a person to be a resident of the 15 political subdivision or municipal corporation of the state for which he 16 or she shall be chosen or within which his or her official functions are 17 required to be exercised, shall not prevent a person from holding the office of village clerk/treasurer and code enforcement officer of the 18 village of Riverside, provided that such person resides in the county in 20 which such village is located or an adjoining county within the state of 21 New York. village clerk/treasurer and code enforcement officer in any other
village shall be a resident of such village, unless otherwise provided
by an act of the state legislature.
