AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to enacting the "voter registration integrity act"

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Short title. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "voter registration integrity act".
- 3 § 2. Section 5-210 of the election law is amended by adding a new 4 subdivision 5-a to read as follows:
- 5 <u>5-a. In addition to documentation of New York residency, the board of</u> 6 <u>elections shall require that each first-time voter registration applica-</u> 7 <u>tion include one of the following:</u>
- 8 (a) an original or certified copy of a birth certificate establishing 9 United States citizenship;
- (b) a valid United States passport;
- 11 (c) a certificate of naturalization or citizenship; or
- 12 <u>(d) such other documentation that the board of elections determines</u> 13 <u>establishes United States citizenship.</u>
- 14 § 3. Clause (D) of subparagraph (vii) of paragraph (k) of subdivision 15 5 of section 5-210 of the election law, as amended by chapter 179 of the 16 laws of 2005, is amended to read as follows:
- 17 (D) a copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, government 18 check, paycheck or other government document that shows the name and 19 address of the voter; and
- 20 <u>(E) in addition to documentation of New York residency, a copy of one</u> 21 of the following:
- 22 <u>(1) an original or certified copy of a birth certificate establishing</u>
  23 <u>United States citizenship;</u>
- 24 (2) a valid United States passport;
- 25 (3) a certificate of naturalization or citizenship; or

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1 (4) such other documentation that the board of elections determines 2 establishes United States citizenship.

3 § 4. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall 4 have become a law. Effective immediately, the addition, amendment and/or 5 repeal of any rule or regulation necessary for the implementation of 6 this act on its effective date are authorized to be made and completed 7 on or before such effective date.
