AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to requiring the commissioner of social services to submit a report on the services provided to human trafficking survivors

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 17 of the social services law is amended by adding a new subdivision (d-1) to read as follows:

3 (d-1) in consultation with the commissioner of the division of crimi-4 nal justice, submit a report to the governor, the speaker of the assembly, the temporary president of the senate and the chairs of the assem-5 bly and senate standing committee on social services, on the services 6 7 provided to human trafficking survivors for the purpose of assessing the 8 availability, utilization and necessity for such services. The initial 9 report shall be provided one year after the effective date of this 10 subdivision and annually thereafter and shall include, but not be limited to, the following: 11 12 (i) the number of human trafficking referrals made to the office of 13 temporary and disability assistance including the number of confirmed 14 cases; (ii) the number of human trafficking survivors that received housing 15 and/or services, with specific information about the type of housing or 16 17 <u>service;</u> (iii) the number of human trafficking survivors that did not receive 18 19 housing and/or services, and an indication as to what type of housing 20 and/or service was requested and whether such housing and/or services 21 were denied due to a lack of availability or because the case was not 22 confirmed; and (iv) information pertaining to the types of services provided by 23

24 providers such as: (1) the number of current contracts to provide hous-

1	ing and services for human trafficking survivors and their annual fund-
2	ing levels, broken down by contract; (2) the number of contracts and/or
3	services that have ended, been terminated or not renewed and the reason
4	why; (3) the types of housing and/or services that are provided, as well
5	as the availability of such services, including the geographic location
	of such housing or service; and (4) any other information the office of
7	temporary and disability assistance deems appropriate.
