AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to requiring schools to include instruction on the prevention of eating disorders as an integral part of their health education programs

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The section heading of section 804 of the education law, as amended by chapter 390 of the laws of 2016, is amended and a new subdivision 5-a is added to read as follows:

4 Health education regarding mental health, alcohol, drugs, tobacco 5 abuse<u>, eating disorders</u> and the prevention and detection of certain 6 cancers.

5-a. All schools shall include, as an integral part of health education provided for all students in grades six through twelve, instruction regarding the prevention of eating disorders as a component of their nutrition programs. Such instruction shall be designed according to the age-appropriate needs and abilities of the pupils at successive grade levels, with the purpose of fostering and developing healthy self-image and preparing pupils to live healthy lives. In developing such instruction, the commissioner may consult with the comprehensive care centers for eating disorders established pursuant to article twenty-seven-j of the public health law.

17 § 2. This act shall take effect on the first of September next 18 succeeding the date upon which it shall have become a law. Effective 19 immediately, the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regu-20 lation necessary for the implementation of this act on its effective 21 date are authorized to be made and completed on or before such effective 22 date.
