AN ACT to amend the general municipal law, in relation to the application of code and ordinance violation administrative adjudication

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 380 of the general municipal law, 2 as amended by chapter 392 of the laws of 2012, is amended to read as 3 follows:

- 1. Any municipality [having a population of more than three hundred thousand but less than three hundred fifty thousand] may adopt a local law establishing an administrative adjudication hearing procedure under the provisions of this article for all code and ordinance violations regarding conditions which constitute a threat or danger to the public health, safety or welfare. Such bureaus shall be responsible for the impartial administration and conduct of adjudicatory proceedings in such municipality.
- 12 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
