AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to aggravated harassment of a police officer

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 240.33 to read as follows:

§ 240.33 Aggravated harassment of a police officer.

A person is guilty of aggravated harassment of a police officer when, with intent to harass, annoy, threaten or alarm a person whom he or she knows or reasonably should know to be a police officer, he or she causes or attempts to cause such police officer to come into contact with blood, seminal fluid, urine, feces, or the contents of a toilet bowl, by throwing, tossing or expelling such such fluid or material.

The term "police officer" shall mean a police officer as defined in subdivision thirty-four of section 1.20 of the criminal procedure law.

Aggravated harassment of a police officer is a class E felony.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
