AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to the age requirement for voting in a primary election

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 5-102 of the election law is amended by adding a 2 new subdivision 3 to read as follows:
- 3 3. The provisions herein with respect to the age requirement for purposes of qualifying to vote shall not prohibit United States citizens otherwise qualified, who are seventeen years of age, from voting in a primary election, including a presidential primary, if such citizen will be eighteen years of age by the date of the corresponding general election.
 - § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
