- AN ACT prohibiting the incineration of aqueous film-forming foam containing perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances in certain cities

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. 1. The disposal by incineration of aqueous film-forming 2 foam that contains perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances shall be prohibited in a city with an environmental justice area designated by 3 4 the department of environmental conservation and a population of not less than sixteen thousand and not more than seventeen thousand based 5 б upon the two thousand ten federal census. The commissioner of environmental conservation may promulgate any rules or regulations he or she 7 may deem necessary in order to carry out the provisions of this act. 8 9 2. For the purposes of this act:

10 (a) "incineration" includes but is not limited to burning, combustion, 11 pyrolysis, gasification, thermal oxidation (including flameless and 12 regenerative), acid recovery furnace/oxidizer, ore roaster, cement kiln, 13 lightweight aggregate kiln, industrial furnace, boiler and process heat-14 er; and

(b) "perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances" means a class of fluorinated organic chemicals containing at least one fully fluorinated carbon atom.

18 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
