**WHEREAS,** This is the first Southold/Greenport High School Robotics Team to win two regional competitions in one season; the team is now ranked in the top 10% of all active FIRST Robotics Teams worldwide; and

**WHEREAS,** The incredible talent displayed by this team is due in great part to the efforts of Team Advisors Christine Schade and Bob Gammon, skilled and inspirational tutors respected for their ability to develop potential into excellence; and

**WHEREAS,** Poised eagerly with enthusiasm and determined purpose, these students now stand honorably, with just pride in their accomplishments and in eager anticipation of future challenges, understanding and appreciating the caring counsel and support provided by their teachers, advisors and parents; now, therefore, be it
