WHEREAS, After moving to the Rochester area, Hilda R. Escher sought services from the Ibero American Action League, a dual-language human services agency; using her new found skills, she quickly became an involved and active part of her community; and

WHEREAS, In 1975, Hilda R. Escher began her long and distinguished career with Ibero American Action League, the agency which helped her succeed, not only in the classroom, but also in her community; through the years, she rose through the ranks, holding the title of President and CEO from 2006 until her official retirement in 2019; and

WHEREAS, In this capacity, Hilda R. Escher diligently worked to support individuals and families of all ethnic backgrounds with a specific focus on the Latino community; and

WHEREAS, In addition to her work with the Ibero American Action League, Hilda R. Escher served as President of the Rochester Psychiatric Center Board, and is a member of both the Provider Council and the Executive Committee for the Council of Agency Executives, University of Rochester Center for Community Health; and

WHEREAS, For her steadfast and unremitting commitment to her community, Hilda R. Escher was the recipient of the 2019 Athena International Award; and

WHEREAS, It is the sense of this Legislative Body that those who enhance the well-being and vitality of their community and have shown a long and sustained commitment to excellence certainly have earned the recognition and applause of all the citizens of this great Empire State; now, therefore, be it
