WHEREAS, Pronto of Long Island, Inc. offers food stamp assistance, Medicare insurance and United Healthcare - insurance provider information, senior services programs and the Empire Justice program; it also provides English as a Second Language classes and helps people prepare for their United States Citizenship exams; and
