AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to giving and/or receiving unlawful benefits

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 200.31 to 2 read as follows:
- 3 § 200.31 Giving unlawful benefits.
- Anyone who otherwise than as provided by law for the proper discharge of official duty directly or indirectly gives, offers or promises any benefit with a value in excess of three thousand dollars, with the exception of campaign contributions under article fourteen of the election law, to any public official or person selected to be a public official because of that person's official position.
- 10 Giving unlawful benefits is a class E felony.
- 11 § 2. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 200.36 to read 12 as follows:
- 13 <u>§ 200.36 Receiving unlawful benefits.</u>
- 14 Anyone who, being a public official or person selected to be a public
- 15 official, otherwise than as provided by law for the proper discharge of
- 16 official duty, directly or indirectly seeks, receives or agrees to
- 17 receive any benefit, with the exception of campaign contributions under
- 18 article fourteen of the election law, with a value in excess of three
- 19 thousand dollars because of that person's official position.
- 20 Receiving unlawful benefits is a class E felony.
- 21 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
