CONCURRENT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND ASSEMBLY

proposing an amendment to section 9 of article 1 of the constitution, in relation to authorizing gambling on professional sporting events and athletic events sponsored by universities or colleges

1 Section 1. Resolved (if the Assembly concur), That subdivision 1 of 2 section 9 of article 1 of the constitution be amended to read as 3 follows:

1. No law shall be passed abridging the rights of the people peaceably to assemble and to petition the government, or any department thereof; nor shall any divorce be granted otherwise than by due judicial proceedings; except as hereinafter provided, no lottery or the sale of lottery tickets, pool-selling, book-making, or any other kind of gamblexcept lotteries operated by the state and the sale of lottery 10 tickets in connection therewith as may be authorized and prescribed by the legislature, the net proceeds of which shall be applied exclusively 12 to or in aid or support of education in this state as the legislature may prescribe, except pari-mutuel betting on horse races as may be 13 14 prescribed by the legislature and from which the state shall derive a 15 reasonable revenue for the support of government, and except casino gambling at no more than seven facilities as authorized and prescribed by the legislature shall hereafter be authorized or allowed within this 17 state; and except wagering on professional sporting events and athletic 18 events sponsored by universities or colleges at betting facilities 19 20 located at thoroughbred and harness racetracks operating in this state, in simulcast theaters operated by off-track betting corporations, on 22 mobile platforms, and in any constitutionally authorized casino facili-23 ty, as may be prescribed by the legislature, the net proceeds of which shall be applied exclusively to or in aid or support of education in 25 this state as the legislature may prescribe, and the legislature shall

1 pass appropriate laws to prevent offenses against any of the provisions 2 of this section.

§ 2. Resolved (if the Assembly concur), That the foregoing amendment 4 be referred to the first regular legislative session convening after the 5 next succeeding general election of members of the assembly, and, in 6 conformity with section 1 of article 19 of the constitution, be 7 published for 3 months previous to the time of such election.
