AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to authorizing and directing the commissioner of education to develop a program for certain veterans to receive high school diplomas

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Section 305 of the education law is amended by adding a new subdivision 29-c to read as follows:
- 29-c. The commissioner shall develop a program whereby any veteran of
  the armed forces who has served on active duty in the United States
  Armed Forces, and who was unable, for any reason, to complete a secondary education, may be awarded a high school diploma based on knowledge
  and experience gained while in service.
- § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
