AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to making conviction of assault of a social worker a felony

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 120.08 of the penal law, as amended by chapter 476 2 of the laws of 2018, is amended to read as follows:

§ 120.08 Assault on a peace officer, police officer, firefighter [ex], emergency medical services professional or social worker.

A person is guilty of assault on a peace officer, police officer, firefighter [ex], emergency medical services professional or social worker when, with intent to prevent a peace officer, police officer, a firefighter, including a firefighter acting as a paramedic or emergency medical technician administering first aid in the course of performance 10 of duty as such firefighter, [ex] an emergency medical service paramedic 11 or emergency medical service technician[7] or social worker from 12 performing a lawful duty, he or she causes serious physical injury to such peace officer, police officer, firefighter, paramedic [ex], techni-14 cian or social worker.

15 Assault on a peace officer, police officer, firefighter [ex], emergen-16 cy medical services professional or social worker is a class C felony.

§ 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-17 18 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
