AN ACT to amend the county law, in relation to reimbursement for coroner and medical examiner fees from the county where the decedent resided

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The county law is amended by adding a new section 680 to 2 read as follows:

§ 680. Reimbursement. The county with jurisdiction over a decedent may
seek reimbursement for services rendered and fees generated by the
coroner, coroner's physician or medical examiner from the county in
which the decedent resided.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
