AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to the definition of assault weapon

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 22 of section 265.00 of the penal law, as added by chapter 1 of the laws of 2013, is amended to read as follows:
- 4 (a) a semiautomatic rifle that has an ability to accept a detachable 5 magazine and has at least one of the following characteristics:
  - (i) a folding or telescoping stock;
- 7 (ii) [a pistol grip that protrudes conspicuously beneath the action of 8 the weapon;
- 9 (iii) a thumbhole stock;
- 10 [(iii) a second handgrip or a protruding grip that can be held 11 by the non-trigger hand;
- 12  $\left[\frac{(v)}{(iv)}\right]$  a bayonet mount;
- 13  $[\frac{(vi)}{(v)}]$  a flash suppressor, muzzle break, muzzle compensator, or 14 threaded barrel designed to accommodate a flash suppressor, muzzle
- 15 break, or muzzle compensator;
  - 16 [<del>(vii)</del>] <u>(vi)</u> a grenade launcher; or
- 17 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
