AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to
polystyrene waste reduction

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assem-
bly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Article 27 of the environmental conservation law is
2 amended by adding a new title 30 to read as follows:

4 POLYSTYRENE WASTE REDUCTION

5 Section 27-3001. Definitions.
6 27-3003. Prohibited disposable food service containers.
7 27-3005. Required compostable or recyclable disposable food
8 service containers.
9 27-3007. Powers of municipalities.

10 § 27-3001. Definitions.
11 For the purposes of this title, the following terms shall have the
12 following meanings:
13 1. "Affordable" means purchasable for not more than fifteen percent
14 more than the purchase cost of the non-compostable or non-recyclable
15 alternative.
16 2. "Agency" means any state department, agency, board, public benefit
17 corporation, public authority, or commission.
18 3. "Compostable" means all the materials in the product or package
19 meet the American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM) International

1 Standard Specification for Compostable Plastics D6400, and will: (a)
2 undergo degradation by biological processes during composting in an
3 appropriate municipal or industrial composting facility to yield carbon
4 dioxide, water, inorganic compounds, and biomass at a rate consistent
5 with other known compostable materials in similar facilities; and (b)
6 leave no visible, distinguishable or toxic residue, including no adverse
7 impact on the ability of composts to support plant growth once the
8 finished compost is placed in soil.

9 4. "Contractors and lessees" mean any person or entity that has a
10 contract with an agency or a municipality for public works or improve-
11 ments to be performed, for a franchise, concession or lease of property,
12 for grant monies or goods and services or supplies to be purchased at
13 the expense of the agency or municipality or to be paid out of monies
14 deposited in the treasury or out of trust monies under the control or
15 collected by the agency or municipality.

16 5. "Disposable food service container" means all containers, bowls,
17 plates, trays, cartons, cups, lids and other items that are designed or
18 generally recognized by the public as being designed for one-time use to
19 hold, contain, or transport foods, including without limitation,
20 containers for takeout foods and/or leftovers from partially consumed
21 meals prepared by retail food vendors. The term "disposable food service
22 containers" does not include items composed entirely of aluminum or
23 polystyrene foam coolers and ice chests that are intended for reuse.

24 6. "Home compostable" means all the materials in the product or pack-
25 age conform with the Vincotte OK Compost Home certification using the
26 European Norm 13432 standard, or a comparable standard as determined by
27 the department, and will: (a) undergo degradation by biological proc-
28 esses during composting in a home compost pile or device to yield carbon
29 dioxide, water, inorganic compounds, and biomass at a rate consistent
30 with other known compostable materials in similar facilities; and (b)
31 leave no visible, distinguishable or toxic residue, including no adverse
32 impact on the ability of composts to support plant growth once the
33 finished compost is placed in soil.

34 7. "Municipality" means a village, town, city, or county, or any
35 designated agency thereof.

36 8. "Polystyrene foam" means blown polystyrene and expanded and extrud-
37 ed foams that are thermoplastic petrochemical materials utilizing a
38 styrene monomer and processed by any number of techniques including, but
39 not limited to, fusion of polymer spheres, injection molding, foam mold-
40 ing, and extrusion-blown molding. Polystyrene foam is generally used to
41 make cups, bowls, plates, trays, clamshell containers, meat trays and
42 egg cartons. Such term shall not include rigid polystyrene.

43 9. "Recyclable" means material that can be sorted, cleansed and recon-
44 stituted using available recycling collection programs for the purpose
45 of using the altered form in the manufacture of a new product. Recycling
46 does not include burning, incinerating, converting, or otherwise ther-
47 maximally destroying solid waste.

48 § 27-3003. Prohibited disposable food service containers.

49 1. Agencies, municipalities, and their contractors and lessees shall
50 not purchase, acquire, possess, sell, use, or offer for use disposable
51 food service containers that contain polystyrene.

52 2. Nothing in this section shall be construed to govern the activities
53 of contractors and lessees that occur outside of the state or activities
54 of contractors and lessees that occur with entities other than agencies
55 and municipalities.

1 § 27-3005. Required compostable or recyclable disposable food service
2 containers.

3 Agencies, municipalities, and their contractors and lessees shall use
4 disposable food service containers made from material, other than polys-
5 tyrene foam, that is compostable, home compostable or recyclable unless
6 there is no affordable compostable, home compostable or recyclable prod-
7 uct available. Nothing in this section shall be construed to govern the
8 activities of contractors and lessees that occur outside of the state or
9 activities of contractors of lessees that occur with entities other than
10 agencies or municipalities.

11 § 27-3007. Powers of municipalities.

12 Any agency or municipality may promulgate regulations, ordinances, or
13 laws to take any and all reasonable actions necessary to implement and
14 enforce this title.

15 § 2. The department of environmental conservation shall conduct a
16 study on the desirability, feasibility and environmental impact of a
17 statewide prohibition on the use of disposable food service ware that
18 contains polystyrene foam. The department shall issue a report contain-
19 ing the results of the study to the legislature no later than the thir-
20 ty-first of January next succeeding the date on which this act shall
21 have become a law.

22 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately; provided, however, that
23 section one of this act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth
24 day after it shall have become a law.
