AN ACT to amend chapter 504 of the laws of 2016, amending the tax law relating to authorizing the town of Greenburgh to adopt a local law to impose a hotel/motel occupancy tax for hotels not located in a village; authorizing specified villages in the towns of Greenburgh and Mount Pleasant to adopt local laws to impose a hotel/motel occupancy tax in such villages, in relation to extending the effectiveness thereof

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 2 of chapter 504 of the laws of 2016 , amending the tax law relating to authorizing the town of Greenburgh to adopt a local law to impose a hotel/motel occupancy tax for hotels not located in a village; authorizing specified villages in the towns of Greenburgh and Mount Pleasant to adopt local laws to impose a hotel/motel occupancy tax in such villages, is amended to read as follows:
§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately, and shall expire and be deemed repealed September 1, [2019] 2022.
§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
