AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to prohibiting co-payments for outpatient opioid treatment

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Subsection (i) of section 3216 of the insurance law is 2 amended by adding a new paragraph 31-b to read as follows:
- 3 (31-b) Every policy that provides coverage for outpatient opioid 4 treatment shall not impose a co-payment fee on any insured for such 5 treatment.
- 6 § 2. Subsection (1) of section 3221 of the insurance law is amended by 7 adding a new paragraph 7-c to read as follows:
- 8 (7-c) Every policy that provides coverage for outpatient opioid treat-9 ment shall not impose a co-payment fee on any insured for such treat-10 ment.
- 11 § 3. Section 4303 of the insurance law is amended by adding a new 12 subsection (1-3) to read as follows:
- 13 <u>(1-3) Every policy that provides coverage for outpatient opioid treat-</u>
 14 <u>ment shall not impose a co-payment fee on any insured for such treat-</u>
 15 <u>ment.</u>
- 16 § 4. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeed-
- 17 ing the date on which it shall have become a law and shall apply to 18 policies and contracts issued, renewed, modified, altered or amended on
- 19 and after such date.
