AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to the issuance of a superintendent's certificate to persons possessing exceptional qualifications

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 3003 of the education law is amended by adding a 2 new subdivision 3-a to read as follows:

3-a. a. The commissioner, at the request of a board of education or
4 board of cooperative educational services, shall provide for the issu5 ance of a superintendent's certificate to any person possessing excep6 tional qualifications in specific business operations who does not meet
7 all of the graduate course or teaching requirements of subdivision one
8 of this section. For purposes of this subdivision "exceptional quali9 fications" means the candidate has earned a post graduate degree from an
10 accredited college or university and has at least five years experience
11 as chief executive officer of a company or organization. The size of
12 employee work force and annual sales or operating revenues of such
13 company shall be factors considered in the issuance of such a certif14 icate.

b. Any superintendent receiving his or her certificate as superintendent of schools pursuant to paragraph a of this subdivision shall complete twelve semester hours of graduate study in the field of school administration and supervision within two years of receipt of his or her
