AN ACT to amend chapter 635 of the laws of 1963 relating to incorporating the Snyder Volunteer Firemen's Benevolent Association, in relation to its purpose and the use of foreign fire insurance premium taxes

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Sections 1, 3 and 7 of chapter 635 of the laws of 1963 2 relating to incorporating the Snyder Volunteer Firemen's Benevolent Association, are amended to read as follows:

Section 1. Incorporation; membership. A membership corporation by the name of "Snyder Volunteer [Firemen's] Firefighter's Benevolent Association" is hereby created. It shall be composed of such persons eliqible to membership therein as hereinafter provided as shall (a) notify the secretary of Snyder Fire Department, Incorporated in writing prior to 8 the organization meeting of such corporation hereinafter provided for of 10 their desire to become members, or (b) shall attend such meeting or an adjournment thereof, and also such persons so eligible as may become members of such corporation pursuant to its by-laws.

§ 3. Purposes. [The purposes of such corporation shall be the promotion of fraternal intercourse among the members of such corporation, the relief, aid and assistance of such members and their families who are disabled or indigent, and the promotion of the welfare of the fire department service within the Snyder Fire District and territo-18 ry provided with fire protection by contract with such fire district. The purposes of the corporation created by this act are: to provide 20 relief, aid and assistance to the volunteer members of such corporation 21 who are indigent, disabled, or injured in the performance of their

duties, and their families; to maintain a suitable headquarters for the volunteer members of such corporation; to promote and safequard the welfare of the volunteer members of the corporation, and their families; to provide for the health and safety of the volunteer members of the corporation; and to enhance the morale of the volunteer members of the corporation by providing social and recreational activities for the volunteer members of the corporation, and the promotion of the volunteer fire service within the territory protected by such fire department of the Snyder Fire Department, Incorporated.

§ 7. Precept for payment of foreign fire insurance premium taxes. Such corporation shall collect and there shall be paid to it all taxes imposed by [section five hundred fifty-three] section ninety-one hundred four of the insurance law, for fire department use and benefit, upon 14 premiums for insurance against loss or damage by fire covering property situated within the territory protected by the Snyder Fire Department, Incorporated, located in the Town of Amherst, Erie County, New York, or within any duly organized territory in which the Snyder Fire Department, Incorporated is or may be obligated to render fire protection. The officer of said corporation designated by its by-laws to collect and receive the aforesaid tax shall have all the powers and be subject to all the provisions of the insurance law, relating to treasurers of fire departments. Such corporation shall also be entitled to receive a share of the tax imposed by [section five hundred fifty-four] section ninety-one 24 hundred five of the insurance law, based upon the business written in the territory with respect to which it is entitled to collect and receive the tax under [section five hundred fifty-three] section ninety-one hundred four of the insurance law. [Such taxes shall only be used for the care and relief of disabled or indigent volunteer and exempt volunteer firemen and their families | Such taxes shall only be used by the corporation in furtherance of its purposes as set forth in section three of this act.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately; provided however, that the amendments to section 7 of chapter 635 of the laws of 1963 relating to incorporating the Snyder Volunteer Firemen's Benevolent Association made by section one of this act shall apply to taxes due on premiums received on and after January 1, 2020.
