- AN ACT to amend the real property actions and proceedings law, in relation to prohibiting the eviction of tenants for using medical marihuana for a certified medical use

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The real property actions and proceedings law is amended by 2 adding a new section 716 to read as follows:

3 § 716. Certified use of medical marihuana; no grounds. 1. For purposes 4 of this section, the terms "medical marihuana" and "certified medical 5 use" shall have the same meaning set forth in section thirty-three 6 hundred sixty of the public health law.

7 2. No person, corporation, limited liability company, partnership or any other business entity shall commence proceedings pursuant to this article on the grounds that a tenant uses medical marihuana for a certified medical use, provided that such tenant is a patient certified to use medical marihuana pursuant to title five-A of article thirty-three

- 12 of the public health law.
- 13 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
