AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to requiring practitioners who administer naloxone or another overdose reversal agent to a patient in the case of a suspected or confirmed overdose to report the administration of the agent to the prescription monitoring program registry

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 9 of section 3343-a of the public health law is 2 renumbered subdivision 10 and a new subdivision 9 is added to read as follows:

- 9. Administration of overdose reversal agents. (a) Any practitioner who administers naloxone or another overdose reversal agent to a patient 6 in the case of a suspected or confirmed overdose shall report the administration of the agent to the prescription monitoring program registry 8 within seventy-two hours of administration. Such report shall contain the following information if available: (i) the name of the patient; (ii) the address of the patient; (iii) the date of birth of the patient; 11 (iv) the time and place of the administration of the agent; and (v) the 12 identity of the person who administered the naloxone to the patient.
- 13 (b) Any report made pursuant to the terms of this subdivision shall be 14 considered to be made by the reporter in the course of his or her duties and shall be directly related to patient care. 15
  - § 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 2021.
