AN ACT to amend the mental hygiene law, in relation to duties of providers of service to people with developmental disabilities

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 16.13 of the mental hygiene law is amended by adding a new subdivision (e) to read as follows:

(e) Posting a visible notice. Facilities licensed, certified or operated by the office shall post signs in accordance with this subdivision. Such signs shall be posted and visible where employee notices are posted, be not less than eight and one-half inches by eleven inches and shall read: "In case of an emergency, dial 911".

8 § 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after 9 it shall have become a law.
