AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to limiting co-payments for child care subsidies

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 6 of section 410-x of the social services law, 2 as added by section 52 of part B of chapter 436 of the laws of 1997, is amended to read as follows:

- 6. Pursuant to department regulations, child care assistance shall be provided on a sliding fee basis based upon the family's ability to pay.

  No co-payment shall be assessed to a family whose income is at or below the state income standard as defined in subdivision two of section four
- 8 hundred ten-w of this title. Co-payments shall not exceed ten percent of the household income.
- 10 § 2. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeed-11 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
