AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to allowing for classes in computer coding to replace foreign language requirements for graduation

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 817 to read as follows:

S 817. Courses of study in coding. 1. Any school district in the state may provide as an alternative to completing any foreign language requirement required for graduation instruction in computer coding.
2. The commissioner shall provide technical assistance in the development of curricula for such courses of study which shall be age appropriate and developed according to the needs and abilities of pupils at successive grade levels in order to provide pupils with computer coding skills.
§ 2. This act shall take effect on the first of July next succeeding the date on which it shall have become a law. Effective immediately, the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation necessary for the implementation of this act on its effective date are authorized to be made and completed on or before such effective date.
