AN ACT to amend the village law, in relation to the population of a village

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The opening paragraph of subdivision 1 of section 2-200 of 2 the village law is amended to read as follows:

- A territory containing a population of at least [five hundred] one 4 thousand persons who are regular inhabitants thereof, as hereinafter defined, may be incorporated as a village under this chapter provided such territory does not include a part of a city or village and further provided the limits of such territory:
 - § 2. Subparagraph 3 of paragraph b of subdivision 1 of section 2-202 of the village law is amended to read as follows:
- 10 (3) An allegation that such territory contains a population of at least [five hundred] one thousand regular inhabitants. 11
- § 3. Paragraph f of subdivision 1 of section 2-206 of the village law 12 13 is amended to read as follows:
- 14 f. That such territory does not contain a population of at least [five 15 **hundred**] **one thousand** regular inhabitants;
- § 4. This act shall take effect immediately and shall apply to any 17 petitions that have not reached final disposition under the provision of 18 article 2 of the village law prior to the effective date of this act.
