CONCURRENT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND ASSEMBLY

proposing an amendment to article 1 of the constitution, in relation to establishing an economic bill of rights

- 1 Section 1. Resolved (if the Assembly concur), That article 1 of the 2 constitution be amended by adding a new section 19 to read as follows:
- § 19. Every citizen of the state of New York, regardless of his or her income, shall be entitled to the right to:
- 5 (a) a job that pays a living wage;
- 6 (b) quality health care;
  - (c) a complete education;
- 8 (d) affordable housing;

- 9 (e) a clean environment; and
- 10 (f) a secure retirement.
- 11 § 2. Resolved (if the Assembly concur), that the foregoing amendment
- 12 be referred to the first regular legislative session convening after the
- 12 be referred to the first regular legislative session convening after the 13 next succeeding general election of members of the assembly, and, in
- 14 conformity with section 1 of article 19 of the constitution, be
- 15 published for 3 months previous to the time of such election.
