AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to including substances designated pursuant to the federal Analog Act and Controlled Substances Act within the definition of controlled substances

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The opening paragraph of section 3306 of the public health law, as added by chapter 664 of the laws of 1985, is amended to read as follows:

There are hereby established five schedules of controlled substances, to be known as schedules I, II, III, IV and V respectively. Such schedules shall consist of the following substances by whatever name or chemical designation known, and shall include any such substances as shall be designated pursuant to the federal Analog Act (21 U.S.C. § 813) and Controlled Substances Act (21 U.S.C. §§ 801-971), or any regulations adopted pursuant to such acts, including any permanent and emergency regulations adopted by the federal Drug Enforcement Administration:

12 § 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after 13 it shall have become a law.
