AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system as the "Detective First Grade Brian Mulkeen Memorial Highway"

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 344-1 to read as follows:

§ 344-1. Portion of the state highway system to be designated as the 4 "Detective First Grade Brian Mulkeen Memorial Highway". All that portion 5 of the state highway system constituting state route two hundred two 6 within the town of Yorktown, shall be designated and known as the "Detective First Grade Brian Mulkeen Memorial Highway".

- § 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the installation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system as designated pursuant to section one of this act. Such signing shall 11 begin 1,000 feet beyond the town line on both the west and east end of state route 202. However, to avoid confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the designation called for pursuant to section 14 one of this act shall be one of ceremonial nature and the official name 15 of such highway shall not be changed as a result of this act.
- 16 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
