AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to increasing the age required to use ultraviolet radiation devices to twenty-one years of age

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 3555 of the public health law, as  
2 amended by chapter 194 of the laws of 2018, is amended to read as  
3 follows:

4 2. No owner, operator, or employee of a tanning facility shall permit  
5 the use of an ultraviolet radiation device by a person under [~~eighteen~~]  
6 twenty-one years of age.

7 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
