AN ACT to amend the agriculture and markets law, the public health law and the alcoholic beverage control law, in relation to authorizing the manufacture and sale of ice cream and other frozen desserts made with liquor

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivisions 14 and 15 of section 200 of the agriculture 2 and markets law, as amended by chapter 118 of the laws of 2018, are 3 amended to read as follows:

4 14. If it is ice cream or other frozen desserts made with <u>liquor</u>, 5 wine, beer or cider bearing or containing more than five percent of 6 alcohol by volume.

7 15. With respect to the manufacture and sale of ice cream or other 8 frozen desserts made with <u>liquor</u>, wine, beer or cider bearing or 9 containing more than one-half of one percent, but not more than five 10 percent of alcohol by volume:

11 (a) No person shall sell at retail packages of ice cream or other 12 frozen desserts made with <u>liquor</u>, wine, beer or cider for consumption 13 off the premises where sold unless:

14 (i) each package is a sealed package, as received from the manufactur-15 er or distributor;

16 (ii) each sealed package, as received from the manufacturer or 17 distributor, in a format to be established or approved by the commis-18 sioner, prominently bears the following statements, provided that such 19 statements may refer to either <u>liquor</u>, wine, beer or cider or a combina-20 tion thereof:

21 (A) The sale of this product to individuals under the age of twenty-22 one years is prohibited.

(B) This product is made with (insert <u>liquor</u>, wine, beer and/or cider)
 and contains alcohol up to five percent by volume.

EXPLANATION--Matter in <u>italics</u> (underscored) is new; matter in brackets [-] is old law to be omitted.

1 (C) Notice. This product contains alcohol used as a flavoring and, as 2 with any product that contains alcohol: 3 (1) women should not consume alcohol during pregnancy because of the risk of birth defects, and 4 5 (2) consumption of alcohol impairs your ability to drive a car or б operate machinery, and may cause health problems. 7 (iii) the following advisory, on a sign or poster not less than seven 8 inches by five inches, in a format to be established or approved by the 9 commissioner, is displayed prominently at each location where packages 10 of ice cream or other frozen desserts made with liquor, wine, beer or cider are made available to the public provided that such sign or poster 11 may refer to either liquor, wine, beer or cider or a combination there-12 13 of: 14 "THIS AREA CONTAINS (INSERT LIQUOR, WINE, BEER AND/OR 15 CIDER) ICE CREAM OR OTHER FROZEN DESSERTS 16 The sale of (INSERT LIQUOR, WINE, BEER AND/OR CIDER) ICE CREAM OR 17 OTHER FROZEN DESSERTS to individuals under the age of twenty-one years 18 is prohibited. 19 (INSERT LIQUOR, WINE, BEER AND/OR CIDER) ICE CREAM OR OTHER FROZEN 20 DESSERTS contain alcohol up to five percent by volume. 21 (INSERT LIQUOR, WINE, BEER AND/OR CIDER) ICE CREAM OR OTHER NOTICE: FROZEN DESSERTS contain alcohol used as a flavoring and, as with any 22 product that contains alcohol: 23 (1) women should not consume alcohol during pregnancy because of the 24 25 risk of birth defects, and 26 (2) consumption of alcohol impairs your ability to drive a car or 27 operate machinery, and may cause health problems. 28 IT IS A VIOLATION PUNISHABLE UNDER LAW FOR ANY PERSON UNDER THE AGE OF 29 TWENTY-ONE TO PRESENT ANY WRITTEN EVIDENCE OF AGE WHICH IS FALSE, FRAU-30 DULENT OR NOT ACTUALLY HIS OR HER OWN FOR THE PURPOSE OF ATTEMPTING TO 31 PURCHASE (INSERT LIQUOR, WINE, BEER AND/OR CIDER) ICE CREAM OR OTHER 32 FROZEN DESSERTS." 33 (b) No manufacturer and/or distributor of ice cream or other frozen desserts made with liquor, wine, beer or cider shall sell such product: 34 35 (i) to a person intending to sell at retail individual servings of ice 36 cream or other frozen desserts made with liquor, wine, beer or cider, 37 unless, with each shipment, such manufacturer and/or distributor 38 provides: 39 (A) a written notice that individual servings of ice cream or other frozen desserts made with liquor, wine, beer or cider may be sold at 40 retail only where the retailer complies with all of the requirements set 41 42 forth in paragraph (a) of this subdivision, and 43 (B) a written copy of such requirements; and 44 (ii) to a person intending to sell at retail packages of ice cream or 45 other frozen desserts made with liquor, wine, beer or cider for consump-46 tion off the premises, unless, with each shipment, such manufacturer 47 and/or distributor provides: 48 (A) a written notice that packages of ice cream or other frozen desserts made with liquor, wine, beer or cider may be sold at retail 49 50 only where the retailer complies with all of the requirements set forth 51 in paragraph (a) of this subdivision, and 52 (B) a written copy of such requirements. 53 § 2. Section 1352-c of the public health law, as amended by chapter 54 118 of the laws of 2018, is amended to read as follows: 55 § 1352-c. Ice cream or other frozen desserts made with liquor, wine, 56 beer or cider. No person shall sell at retail individual servings of ice

1 cream or other frozen desserts made with liquor, wine, beer or cider 2 bearing or containing more than one-half of one percent but not more than five percent of alcohol by volume, unless the following statements 3 are prominently displayed on the printed menu (or, if no printed menus 4 5 are used, on the menu board or sign setting forth the bill of fare) б immediately adjacent to the listing of the item or items of ice cream or 7 other frozen desserts made with liquor, wine, beer or cider being 8 offered provided that such statements may refer to liquor, wine, beer or 9 cider or a combination thereof:

10 1. The sale of (insert <u>liquor</u>, wine, beer and/or cider) ice cream or 11 other frozen desserts to individuals under the age of twenty-one is 12 prohibited.

13 2. (Insert <u>liquor</u>, wine, beer and/or cider) ice cream or other frozen
14 desserts contain alcohol up to five percent by volume.

15 3. Notice: (Insert <u>liquor</u>, wine, beer and/or cider) ice cream or other 16 frozen desserts contain alcohol used as a flavoring and, as with any 17 product that contains alcohol:

18 (a) women should not consume alcohol during pregnancy because of the 19 risk of birth defects, and

20 (b) consumption of alcohol impairs your ability to drive a car or 21 operate machinery, and may cause health problems.

S 3. Subdivision 1 of section 3 of the alcoholic beverage control law, as amended by chapter 118 of the laws of 2018, is amended to read as follows:

25 1. "Alcoholic beverage" or "beverage" mean and include alcohol, spir-26 its, liquor, wine, beer, cider and every liquid, solid, powder or crys-27 tal, patented or not, containing alcohol, spirits, wine or beer and capable of being consumed by a human being, and any warehouse receipt, 28 certificate, contract or other document pertaining thereto; except that 29 confectionery containing alcohol as provided by subdivision twelve of 30 31 section two hundred of the agriculture and markets law and ice cream and 32 other frozen desserts made with liquor, wine, beer or cider as provided 33 in subdivision fifteen of section two hundred of the agriculture and 34 markets law shall not be regulated as an "alcoholic beverage" or "bever-35 age" within the meaning of this section where the sale, delivery or giving away is to a person aged twenty-one years or older. The sale, 36 delivery or giving away of ice cream or other frozen desserts made with 37 liquor, wine, beer or cider to a person under the age of twenty-one 38 39 years may be prosecuted administratively and/or criminally in accordance with the provisions of this chapter. 40

41 § 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
