Introduced by Sen. KAPLAN -- read twice and ordered printed, and when printed to be committed to the Committee on Education -- committee discharged, bill amended, ordered reprinted as amended and recommitted to said committee

AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to establishing an educational program related to the prevention of anti-Semitism and discrimination based on religion, race, sexual orientation or gender identity or expression

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 305 of the education law is amended by adding a new  
2 subdivision 59 to read as follows:

3 59. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, and  
4 subject to an appropriation, the department shall contract with an  
5 outside entity who has expertise in the prevention of anti-Semitism and  
6 discrimination based on religion, race, sexual orientation or gender  
7 identity or expression to establish an anti-Semitism and discrimination  
8 prevention and education program overseen by such department. The  
9 commissioner shall work with such outside entity, to establish and  
10 develop an educational program within such department related to the  
11 prevention of anti-Semitism and discrimination based on religion, race,  
12 sexual orientation or gender identity or expression in grades kindergar-  
13 ten through twelve. Such program shall be further defined by such  
14 commissioner in regulation and shall be designed to educate students,  
15 parents and school personnel about the prevention of anti-Semitism and  
16 discrimination based on religion, race, sexual orientation or gender  
17 identity or expression. Such commissioner, in collaboration with any  
18 other stakeholder groups deemed appropriate by such commissioner, shall  
19 develop:

20 a. the anti-Semitism and discrimination prevention and education  
21 program prepared by an outside expert organization into age-appropriate  
22 model curriculum resources, including exemplar lesson plans, and best  
23 practice instructional resources for students, parents and school  
24 personnel designed to prevent anti-Semitism and discrimination based on

1 religion, race, sexual orientation or gender identity or expression.  
2 Such model curriculum, resources, lesson plans and instructional  
3 resources shall include but not be limited to guidelines and methods of  
4 prevention, indicators and warning signs of anti-Semitism and discrimi-  
5 nation based on religion, race, sexual orientation or gender identity or  
6 expression, guidelines and methods to prevent anti-Semitism and discrim-  
7 ination based on religion, race, sexual orientation or gender identity  
8 or expression and how to report complaints of anti-Semitism and discrim-  
9 ination based on religion, race, sexual orientation or gender identity  
10 or expression. Such model curriculum shall be made available to school  
11 boards, school superintendents, their equivalents, and teachers for  
12 voluntary implementation in social studies classes and in social studies  
13 coursework;

14 b. instructional tools and materials for students, parents and school  
15 personnel, which shall include updated information on how to report  
16 incidents of anti-Semitism and discrimination based on religion, race,  
17 sexual orientation or gender identity or expression, with a review of  
18 such information to occur periodically, at intervals deemed appropriate  
19 by such commissioner; and

20 c. public availability of all materials related to the anti-Semitism  
21 and discrimination prevention and education program on such department's  
22 website in Spanish, Creole, Mandarin, Korean, Bengali and any other  
23 language predominantly spoken by the population of the state.

24 § 2. This act shall take effect on the first of July next succeeding  
25 the date on which it shall have become a law. Effective immediately, the  
26 addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation necessary  
27 for the implementation of this act on its effective date are authorized  
28 to be made and completed on or before such effective date.
