AN ACT to amend the business corporation law and the limited liability company law, in relation to directing the secretary of state to provide information to certain new businesses

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 408 of the business corporation law is amended by  
2 adding a new paragraph 9 to read as follows:

3 9. Upon the receipt of a statement for filing by the secretary of  
4 state pursuant to this section, the secretary of state shall confirm  
5 such receipt by mail to the corporation at the address set forth in such  
6 statement. In addition, the secretary of state shall include, but not be  
7 limited to including, the following information in such mailing:

8 (a) contact information, including, but not limited to website,  
9 address and telephone number, of the New York state small business  
10 development center serving their region;

11 (b) contact information, including, but not limited to website,  
12 address and telephone number, of the New York state entrepreneurship  
13 assistance center serving their region;

14 (c) contact information, including, but not limited to, the website,  
15 address and telephone number of business mentor NY; and

16 (d) contact information, including, but not limited to website,  
17 address and telephone number, of empire state development. Information  
18 regarding empire state development shall include direction to resources  
19 available on such website to support and assist new businesses.

20 § 2. Section 205 of the limited liability company law is amended by  
21 adding a new subdivision (e) to read as follows:

22 (e) Upon the receipt of an application to reserve a limited liability  
23 company name by the department of state pursuant to this section, the  
24 department shall confirm such receipt by mail to the limited liability  
25 company at the address set forth in such application. In addition, such

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1 department shall include, but not be limited to including, the following  
2 information in such mailing:

3 (1) contact information, including, but not limited to website,  
4 address and telephone number, of the New York state small business  
5 development center serving their region;

6 (2) contact information, including, but not limited to website,  
7 address and telephone number, of the New York state entrepreneurship  
8 assistance center serving their region;

9 (3) contact information, including, but not limited to, the website,  
10 address and telephone number of business mentor NY; and

11 (4) contact information, including, but not limited to website,  
12 address and telephone number, of empire state development. Information  
13 regarding empire state development shall include direction to resources  
14 available on such website to support and assist new businesses.

15 § 3. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall  
16 have become a law.
