AN ACT to provide for the development, expansion, and/or operation of substance abuse supports and services for treatment, recovery, and prevention of heroin and opiate use and addiction disorders; and making an appropriation therefor

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The sum of seventy-five million dollars (\$75,000,000) is
2 hereby appropriated to the office of addiction services and supports out
3 of any moneys in the state treasury in the general fund to the credit of
4 the state purposes account for services and expenses to support efforts
5 to develop, expand, and/or operate substance abuse supports and services
6 for treatment, recovery, and prevention of heroin and opiate use and
7 addiction disorders including but not limited to the provision of hous-
8 ing services for affected populations. Notwithstanding any other
9 provision of law to the contrary, the expenditures from this appropri-
10 ation, and any portion of the money hereby appropriated may be trans-
11 ferred from this appropriation to the local assistance, state oper-
12 ations, and/or capital projects appropriations of the office of
13 addiction services and supports and/or any other appropriation of the
14 office of addiction services and supports. Notwithstanding sections 112
15 and 163 of the state finance law and section 142 of the economic devel-
16 opment law, or any other inconsistent provision of law, funds available
17 for expenditure pursuant to this appropriation for the development,
18 expansion, and/or operation of treatment, recovery, prevention and/or
19 housing services for persons with heroin and opiate use and addiction
20 disorders, may be allocated and distributed by the commissioner of the
21 office of addiction services and supports, subject to approval of the
22 director of the budget, without a competitive bid or request for
23 proposal process. Prior to an award being granted to an applicant pursu-
24 ant to this process, the commissioner of the office of addiction
25 services and supports shall formally notify in writing the chair of the
26 senate finance committee and the chair of the assembly ways and means

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1 committee of the intent to grant such an award. Such notice shall
2 include information regarding how the prospective recipient meets objec-
3 tive criteria established by the commissioner of the office of addiction
4 services and supports.

5 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
