The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Section 5 of chapter 589 of the laws of 2015, amending the insurance law relating to catastrophic or reinsurance coverage issued to certain small groups, as amended by chapter 202 of the laws of 2019, is amended to read as follows:
- 5 § 5. This act shall take effect on the same date and in the same 6 manner as a chapter of the laws of 2015 amending the insurance law 7 relating to catastrophic or reinsurance coverage issued to certain small 8 groups, as proposed in legislative bills numbers S.5928-A and A.8134-A, 9 takes effect [and shall be deemed repealed six years thereafter].
- 10 § 2. Section 5 of chapter 588 of the laws of 2015, amending the insur-11 ance law relating to catastrophic or reinsurance coverage issued to 12 certain small groups, as amended by chapter 202 of the laws of 2019, is 13 amended to read as follows:
- 14 § 5. This act shall take effect immediately[+ and shall be deemed 15 repealed 6 years after it shall have become a law].
- 16 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
