- AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to using supplemental nutrition assistance program benefits to purchase online groceries and to the state supplemental nutrition assistance program outreach program

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subparagraph (i) of paragraph a of subdivision 7 of section 95 of the social services law, as separately amended by chapter 41 and section 3 of part A of chapter 57 of the laws of 2012, is amended to read as follows: (i) May be redeemed for SNAP benefits at designated redemption centers

by the recipient or by an authorized representative. When an eligible б recipient under this section is issued SNAP benefits, such SNAP benefits 7 may be used to purchase food items from a food distributor by the recip-8 9 ient or by an authorized representative. Recipients shall be able to 10 use SNAP benefits to purchase groceries from eligible online grocery 11 retailers and to have groceries delivered pursuant to federal laws and 12 regulations. The department shall enter into an agreement with any online grocery retailer that is eligible to participate in the federal 13 14 SNAP Online Purchasing Pilot program or subsequent programs. Any other 15 transfer or sale of authorizations to participate or SNAP benefits shall 16 constitute an unauthorized use of said authorizations or benefits; 17 § 2. Section 95-a of the social services law, as added by chapter 546 of the laws of 1978, is amended to read as follows: 18 19 § 95-a. State [food stamp] supplemental nutrition assistance program 20 outreach program. 1. In accordance with federal requirements and to 21 the extent that federal matching funds are available, the department 22 shall develop and implement an outreach plan to inform low-income house-23 holds potentially eligible to receive [food stamps] supplemental nutri-24 tion assistance program benefits of the availability and benefits of the 25 program, including information on the federal SNAP Online Purchasing

1 **<u>Pilot program or subsequent programs</u>**, and to encourage the participation 2 of eligible households that wish to participate.

3 2. In developing and implementing such a plan the department and/or 4 its local districts are authorized and empowered, subject to the 5 approval of the director of the budget and provided that federal aid is 6 available therefor, to enter into contractual agreements with public 7 and/or private organizations to develop and implement local, regional, 8 and statewide outreach programs.

9 3. Each commissioner of social services shall develop and submit to department on an annual basis for its approval, a local outreach 10 the 11 plan governing the use of local social services personnel and services provided by federally funded and other agencies and organizations to 12 13 inform potentially eligible households of the availability and benefits 14 of the program and to encourage and facilitate the participation of 15 eligible households. The department shall provide commissioners of 16 social services with technical assistance as needed to carry out the 17 provisions of this subdivision.

4. As part of each local outreach plan, social services officials 18 19 shall take all steps necessary to maintain a supply of information leaf-20 lets in public buildings, including but not limited to local unemploy-21 ment insurance and employment services offices of the department of labor, institutions and facilities under the supervision or control of 22 the department of health, food stores, union halls, community centers 23 24 and local agencies providing services to the elderly to help insure that 25 eligible persons are informed of the [food stamp] supplemental nutrition 26 assistance program.

27 5. The department shall periodically distribute to all newspapers, and 28 to television and radio stations throughout the state, public service 29 announcements describing the [food stamp] supplemental nutrition assist-30 ance program, including the toll-free telephone numbers for [food stamp] 31 supplemental nutrition assistance program information, and shall prompt-32 ly inform such media of significant changes in the program affecting 33 eligibility requirements and/or the amount of the [food stamp] supple-34 mental nutrition assistance program bonus.

35 6. The department shall establish procedures in cooperation with the 36 industrial commissioner of the department of labor to ensure that infor-37 mational leaflets about the [food stamp] supplemental nutrition assist-38 ance program are sent to each local employment services office for 39 distribution pursuant to section five hundred [and] forty of the labor Each leaflet shall include but not be limited to: the phone number 40 law. 41 for the New York State [food stamp] supplemental nutrition assistance 42 hotline, estimated maximum income eligibility levels by household size 43 for participation in the [food stamp] supplemental nutrition assistance program and the availability of local social services departments to 44 45 provide additional information about the program.

46 7. In accordance with applicable federal laws, rules and regulations 47 the department shall make available appropriate bilingual materials so 48 that potentially eligible non English speaking individuals may be 49 informed about the [food stamp] supplemental nutrition assistance 50 program.

51 8. The department shall promulgate rules and regulations, and take 52 all other actions necessary for the effective implementation of this 53 section.
