AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to requiring residential health care facilities to submit an annual pandemic emergency plan to the commissioner of health

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 2803 of the public health law is amended by adding 2 a new subdivision 12 to read as follows:
- 3 12. (a) Each residential health care facility shall, no later than 4 January first, two thousand twenty-one and annually thereafter, submit 5 to the commissioner for approval a pandemic emergency plan which shall 6 include but not be limited to:
- 7 <u>(i) a communication plan to update families and guardians twice per</u> 8 <u>day on a patient's condition;</u>
- 9 (ii) protection plans against infection for staff, patients and fami-10 lies, including:
- 11 (A) a plan for hospitalized patients to be cleared of infection prior 12 to readmission to such residential health care facility; and
- 13 (B) a plan for such residential health care facility to maintain at 14 least a two-month supply of personal protective equipment; and
- 15 <u>(iii) a plan for preserving a patient's place in a residential health</u> 16 <u>care facility if such patient is hospitalized.</u>
- 17 (b) The commissioner shall audit each residential health care facility
 18 for compliance with its plan and the applicable regulations on an annual
 19 basis.
- facility shall submit a plan of correction in such form and manner as specified by the commissioner for achieving compliance with its plan and
- 24 with the applicable regulations. The commissioner shall audit each such
- 25 <u>residential health care facility for compliance with its plan and the</u>
- 26 applicable regulations within a reasonable time after submission of such
- 27 plan of correction.
