AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to exempting certain sales from the tax on alcoholic beverages; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon the expiration thereof

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 424 of the tax law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 7 to read as follows:

- 7. Notwithstanding any other provision of this article, there shall be 4 exempt from the taxes imposed under this article, alcoholic beverages 5 sold at retail by a licensed producer of alcoholic beverages to a 6 customer where such sale occurs either at the brewery, winery or distillery where such alcoholic beverage was produced, or as a direct delivery from the licensed producer of alcoholic beverages to the customer.
- 9 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall expire and be 10 deemed repealed one year after such date.
