- Introduced by Sen. SAVINO -- read twice and ordered printed, and when printed to be committed to the Committee on Labor
- AN ACT to amend the labor law, in relation to prohibiting health care employers from penalizing employees because complaints of employer violations

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 2 of section 741 of the labor law, as added by chapter 24 of the laws of 2002, is amended to read as follows:

4 (a) discloses or threatens to disclose to a supervisor, or to a public 5 body<u>, or to the general public</u> an activity, policy or practice of the 6 employer or agent that the employee, in good faith, reasonably believes 7 constitutes improper quality of patient care; or

8 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
