AN ACT to amend the labor law, in relation to prohibiting health care employers from penalizing employees because complaints of employer violations

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 2 of section 741 of the labor 2 law, as added by chapter 24 of the laws of 2002, is amended to read as 3 follows:
- 4 (a) discloses or threatens to disclose to a supervisor, or to a public 5 body, or to the general public an activity, policy or practice of the 6 employer or agent that the employee, in good faith, reasonably believes 7 constitutes improper quality of patient care; or
- § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
