AN ACT in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system as the "Putnam County Workers Memorial Bridge"

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any other law, ruling, regulation, determination or order, the MTA Metro-North Railroad-owned bridge on Prospect Hill road, just south of the Southeast station, crossing the Harlem Line tracks and parts of MTA Metro-North Railroad's Brewster Yard within the town of Southeast, county of Putnam, shall be designated and known as the "Putnam County Workers Memorial Bridge".

7 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
