AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to the refilling of prescriptions as an emergency prescription

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 6810 of the education law is amended by adding a 2 new subdivision 16 to read as follows:
- 3 <u>16. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a pharmacist may</u> 4 <u>refill a prescription as an emergency prescription, when:</u>
- 5 (a) the pharmacist first attempts to obtain an authorization from the authorized prescriber and cannot obtain the authorization;
- 7 (b) the drug which is the subject of the refill is not a controlled 8 substance;
- 9 (c) the drug which is the subject of the refill is essential to the 10 maintenance of life;
- 11 (d) the drug which is the subject of the refill is essential to the
 12 continuation of therapy in chronic conditions, and, in the pharmacist's
 13 professional judgment, the interruption of the therapy reasonably might
 14 produce an undesirable health consequence, be detrimental to the
 15 patient's welfare or cause physical or mental discomfort;
- 16 (e) the pharmacist enters on the back of the prescription or on anoth-17 er appropriate, uniformly maintained and readily retrievable record, the 18 date and quantity of the refill, and, in addition, the pharmacist signs 19 the refill;
- 20 (f) the pharmacist provides only one refill of the prescription and
 21 the quantity of that refill is in conformity with the prescribed
 22 directions for use, but limited to a seventy-two hour emergency supply,
 23 provided that if the prescription is not dispensed or sold in a seven24 ty-two hour supply, an amount not to exceed a thirty-day emergency
- 25 supply may be dispensed or sold; and
- 26 (g) within seventy-two hours of dispensing the refill, the pharmacist 27 notifies the prescriber that an emergency prescription has been 28 dispensed.
- 29 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
